PRE-PRIMARY CAMP Session Themes & Dates

Sessions 1&2 Surf's Up (June 15-19, 22-26)

Hit the beach with our "Surf's Up" session that will have your child exploring with water, sand castle building and beach art activities. By the end of the session, your child will be more than ready to go Oceanside!

Session 3 Stars and Stripes (June 29-July 2) - (4-Day Camp)

This session is dedicated to our amazing country! Let's get patriotic and learn how this great country was founded! Parades, songs and projects galore will be used in the discovery of our nation!

Sessions 4&5 Art & Literature (July 6-10, 13-17)

In these sessions, your child will get creative through art projects based on classic children books. They will read the story then explore the story through different mediums.

Sessions 6&7 Music and Motion (July 20-24, 27-31)

These sessions, singing and movement become the focus as a means to enhance vocal development and expressive language. Your child will be introduced to musical concepts, patterns and learning how to develop their "musical ear".

Sessions 8&9 Nature Rangers (Aug 3-7, 10-14)

In these nature driven camp, your child will explore the world of creatures and plants around them. They will take nature walks, explore the trails surrounding the school, collect items for a scavenger hunt and even plant and tend to their own school garden.

Session 10 Cooking (Aug 17-20) - (4-Day Camp)

Children of all ages love to cook. In this session your child will explore food by helping to prepare snacks and meals! They will get their hands on new exciting foods, get introduced to delicious new recipes and have fun getting messy!

Field Trips/In-House Presentations

The DC Metro area provides a wonderful resource just waiting to be discovered! Our Primary and Elementary aged students go on frequent field trips and enjoy in-house presentations.



Details

It must be understood that the staff have professional and personal responsibilities after each dismissal time. Therefore, parents who do not pick up their children from camp by the contracted dismissal time will incur over-time charges at the rate of \$25 for the first 15 minutes or any fraction thereof and \$1/minute thereafter—based on the clock in the front office. Overtime charges will be billed and are due upon receipt.

Sunset Club Drop-In will be available at a rate of \$12/hour for one child and \$20/hour for 2 or more children. This service is available for those parents requesting that their child arrive earlier or stay later than the contracted agreement.

There will be no reduction made to this contract in the middle of a camp session. If you choose to pick up your child earlier than the contracted time, either on a temporary or permanent basis, there can be no adjustment made to this contract for the remainder of the summer camp session.

Checks should be made payable to SHMS

A 50% deposit is required for each session, due with signed registration form. A 5% discount will be given for siblings and for enrollment in all 10 sessions.

The balance of each session is due one week prior to the start of the session. No refunds will be made for days missed due to illness, weather or holidays.

<p>Art- (June 15th-June 19th) Foster your child’s creative side through this week of artistic exploration. Your child will learn to focus their creativity and mold it into their own artistic style through a variety of projects.</p>
<p>Surf’s Up- (June 22nd-June 26th) Take a dive into the deep blue! This week will be totally gnarly as we ride the waves to several of the area’s water hot spots, including Lake Audubon Pool and Volcano Island!</p>
<p>Stars and Stripes- (June 29th-July 2nd) - (4-Day Camp) This session is dedicated to our amazing country! Let’s get patriotic and learn how this great country was founded! Parades, songs and projects galore will be used in the discovery of our nation!</p>
<p>World Games- (July 6th-July 10th) Your child will spend the entire week discovering games from around the world as well as designing new games to be enjoyed by all. This week will conclude with our annual Sunset Hills World Games!</p>
<p>Music and Motion- (July 13th-July 17th) This week, singing and movement become the focus as a means to enhance vocal development and expressive language. Your child will be introduced to musical concepts, patterns and learning how to develop their “musical ear”.</p>
<p>Nature Rangers- (July 20th-July 24th) This session is designed to instill a love of the outdoors in your child. From fishing to nature walks and the basics of camping, your child will get the true summer camp experience right here in beautiful Reston!</p>
<p>Health and Fitness- (July 27th-July 31st) In this session your child will learn to take care of their body through proper nutrition and exercise. The children will be introduced to the food pyramid as well as different games and sports to give options for daily exercise.</p>
<p>In The Kitchen- (August 3rd-August 7th) Get ready to find your way around the kitchen! This session is great for aspiring Chefs! Learn about nutrition, safety in the kitchen, and even create some yummy treats!</p>
